Mr. Seah is Chairman of Singapore's Technical Committee for Bunkering (TC) since 1992.

In 2009, Mr. Seah jointly initiated the pioneering Singapore Mass Flow Metering Project. He led it as the Convenor of the TC-appointed Working Group on Mass Flow Metering (WG MFM) from 2009 to Apr 2014, during which the WG achieved several milestones and established the principles, requirements and procedures for a new metering standard for bunkering. As TC Chairman, he guides the development of the new Mass Flow Metering standard by the WG MFM.

As the Singapore Port Authority (PSA)'s Bunkering Services Manager from 1988 to 1996, Mr. Seah started and steered SIBCON and established the governance framework of the nascent Singapore bunkering industry, from the licensing of bunker suppliers and craft operators to the pioneering development and implementation of bunkering standards including the Singapore Bunkering Procedure (SBP) and SS CP60, the forerunner of SS 600.

Mr. Seah graduated in 1976 with a Bachelor of Science (Honours) degree from the University of Southampton, UK.
