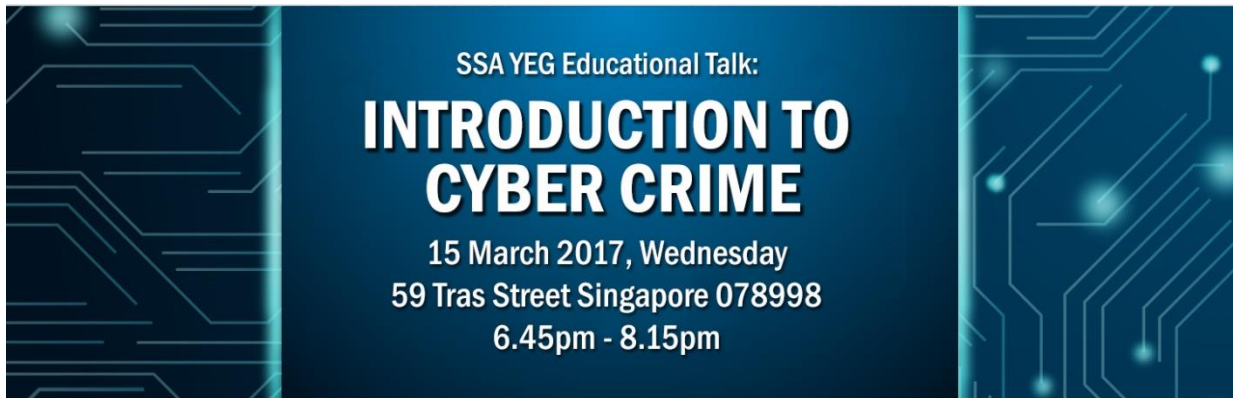

Speaker: Mr Richard James Hancock, Regional Director, NYA International Limited

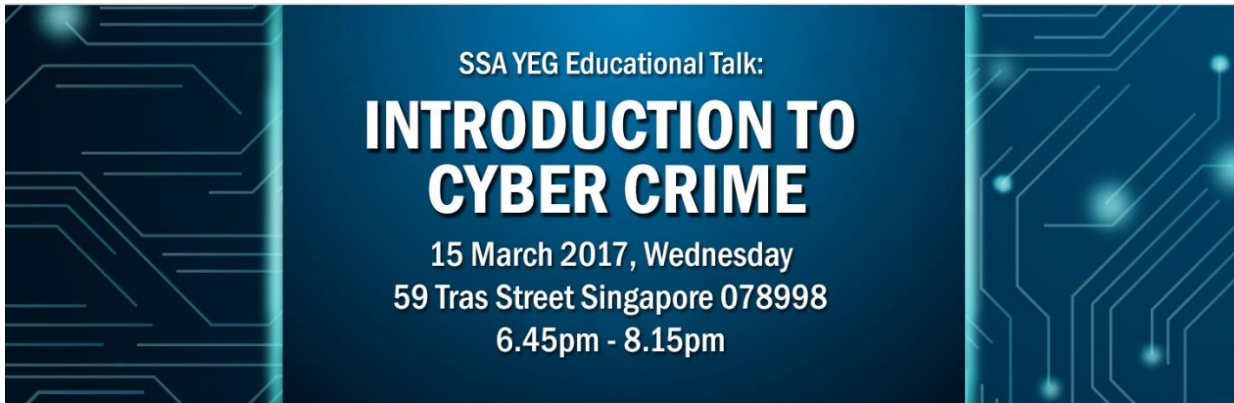
