The Singapore War Risks Insurance Conditions (SWRIC) was developed as part of SSA's efforts to develop Singapore into an important maritime insurance hub. The SWRIC was also developed to augment the Singapore War Risks Mutual (SWRM) which was launched in 2015.

Launched at the SSA's Lunar New Year Cocktail in January 2019 by the Senior Minister of State, Ministry of Transport & Ministry of Health, Dr. Lam Pin Min, the SWRIC aims to bridge coverage gaps, update and simplify existing war conditions in the market. SWRIC is the first set of insurance conditions to be written by shipowners, for shipowners.

To familiarise interested and potential users with the SWRIC, SSA will be organising a seminar-cum-workshop session to discuss on the SWRIC. The seminar-cum-workshop session will touch on the following areas:

- Realities affecting the need for war risk insurance
- Purpose and design of the new SWRIC clauses
- How the SWRIC will work in various current situations including the B Atlantic
