We are pleased to announce that Skills Future has appointed ICS Singapore as the Programme Manager (PM) for the Earn and Learn Programme (ELP) in Shipowning, Operating, and Broking.

SkillsFuture is a national movement to provide Singaporeans with the opportunities to develop their fullest potential throughout life, regardless of their starting points.

The SkillsFuture Earn and Learn Programme is a work-learn program that gives fresh graduates from polytechnics a head-start in careers related to their discipline of study. It provides them with more opportunities, after graduation, to build on the skills and knowledge they acquired in school, and better supports their transition into the workforce.

Participating companies will enjoy financial grants up to S\$12,000.

ICS Singapore as PM will coordinate between companies and participants and manage the program.

How to apply :

Starting Date: 1 July 2019

Ending Date: 31 March 2021

Program Duration: 18month (Includes studying with ICS and On Job Training).

Who can apply?

Individuals:

- Singaporeans and Singapore Permanent Residents
- Fresh Poly graduates who are hired / already hired by the Participating Companies within 36 months after their graduation from their institutions. For male participants, the 36-month period will start from their Operationally Ready Date ("ORD")
