The Maritime Singapore Connect (MSC) Office is pleased to invite you to the second run of the **MSC Connexions Forum on 3 November 2017 (Fri), 2.00pm – 5.00pm** at **Carlton Hotel Singapore (Empress Ballroom 4 & 5), Level 2**.

The MSC Connexions Forum is an annual event organised specially for those in the HR and PR functions of the maritime industry, as well as those working with students and jobseekers in the schools and career centres under Workforce Singapore (WSG) and the Employment and Employability Institute (e2i). It is also a platform for the industry, schools, industry associations and government agencies to get to know one another better, as requested by some of our partners.

Programme Highlights

- ***Skills Framework for Sea Transport*** – SkillsFuture Singapore will give an overview of the Skills Framework for Sea Transport launched earlier this year which the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore has worked with SkillsFuture Singapore and various stakeholders for. The Skills Framework provides key information on sector and employment, career pathways, occupations/job roles, as well as existing and emerging skills required for the occupations/job roles. This is a resource for careers in the sea transport sector developed with individuals, employers and training service providers in mind.
- ***Sea Transport Industry Transformation Map (ITM)*** – The Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore will share about its work on the development of the ITM, which is expected to be launched early next year. This is one of the industry-specific ITMs that the Future Economy Council, led by Minister (Finance) Heng Swee Keat, oversees. Each ITM is supported by the four pillars of Innovation, Productivity, Jobs & Skills and Internationalisation.
- ***Panel Discussion and Q&A*** – “Developing a Multi-Skilled Maritime Workforce with a Global Mindset”. This is one of the five strategies outlined in the IMC 2030 Strategic Review report released recently. Their sharing would be valuable to

extend the knowledge of the report and generate discussion among a target audience with keen interest on maritime manpower issues.
